From the results of such a broad search you can already learn all sorts of things: Who are the most important authors? Which are the leading journals and research institutes? You will also discover important articles and subjects, as well as any existing solutions to your research question.

The resulting map of your research field will help you find search terms and give you a good basis to judge results when you subsequently perform a literature search for your thesis.

One last thing: Make sure you always document your steps.

Write down search terms and results and also make lists of the authors, institutions, journals and topics you find.
